## Additional costs that may be incurred:

- Swim Meets: The swim team holding the meet charges a fee per swimmer per event. These fees are charged to the Marlins and then put through to your club account. Race fees (approx.): individual races \$8-\$12, relays \$5 per swimmer on relay.
- Optional Team Swimsuit: approximately \$75 (female) and \$50 (male). Prices are approximate. • Optional Team Clothing: Parka (\$150), clothing – hoodies, sweatpants, t-shirts, etc. (various prices). Prices are approximate.
- Team dinners and banquets. Partly subsidized

- Some Hell Week activities (e.g., Grouse Grind Skyride, a movie, Playland). Partly subsidized
- Travel costs if you choose to attend “away” meets.
- Team Aquatics Supply offers a team discount for suits, goggles, fins, etc. You will need a NSW Marlin Team Aquatic Supply Discount Card. Contact a Marlins’ Committee Member for the electronic version of the discount card. You **must show** the discount card to receive the discount (save it on your phone).
